Budget OK, only issue is number of HOPM's to date. If trend continues, which is not expected, then could lead to overspend. SD carefully monitoring.

Coroners officers will have more ownership of files going forward. It has now been approved and supported for some, not all, Coroners Officers to have PIP L1 training. The logistics will be discussed out of this forum, but officers want to be able to offer more support to detectives and police officers.

SB reminded all managers the breadth of SD's knowledge in regards context of death especially and impressed by SD's recent involvement at scene at work on blood pattern analysis.

SD reported on the introduction of all deaths to be scrutinised will be introduced from April 2019. Coroners currently only investigate a small sample. Coronial impact will be that Form A referrals will reduce, however there is likely to be an increase in Post Mortem examinations or medical inquest cases. Details of implementation are not known yet so SD will keep a watching brief and report back.

A discussion followed on payment for HOPM and that conversations are needed with the Coroner if a Hospital trust is refusing to pay despite a case being within their remit.
